This is a Pembroke Welsh Corgi only event with a maximum of 20 dogs. Entry fee for each dog/run is \$55.00 Entries open February 15 and close April 20, 2025

Please arrive with time to park, check in, walk your dog, set up your chair(s), etc.

Each Corgi will be tested one time and given an evaluation. This event will be held Rain or Shine in an outdoor arena. Passing this test does not earn a title.

- Dogs will be tested on "dog broke" goats (goats that are familiar and adapted to close proximity canine herding). A livestock flag will be used during evaluations to guide your dog.
- You will be in a round pen with your dog so wear appropriate shoes (no sandals). Nola will be the one to work your dog. You may take photos.
- After 5 minutes your dog will need a small break. You can bring water or use our pond to cool your dog down. Your dog will be asked to work 5 minutes more.
- The instinct testing time may vary based on the sustained interest of the dog and their desire to work. Testing sessions last approximately 10 minutes per dog.
- At the conclusion Nola will debrief you on your dog's skill level.

Remember to bring water for you and your dog, X-pens or crates if you have them, your own snacks/lunch, chairs, comfortable clothing for heat or cool weather, FLAT COLLAR, leash.

THIS IS A WORKING FARM. Please respect the livestock and the facility. Clean up after your dog and yourself. Children are to be supervised at all times. Any attendee and/or dog who is causing a disturbance will be asked to leave with no refund of entry fees. Nola has invited all to enjoy the pond and the agility field during down times.

All entries will run without a lunch break between dogs. You are welcome to bring your lunch/snacks.

PLEASE NOTIFY US IF YOUR FEMALE IS IN HEAT so we can move her to the end of the day. Females in heat must be crated or in vehicle until her run. Potty break away from others okay.
