AKC SCENT WORK DESCRIPTION & TRIAL RESULTS

The AKC has gotten into the scent work game and it is very popular. The trials began in December 2017 and many clubs are getting authorized to hold trials. Unlike some of the other organizations in scent work, under AKC, a team can qualify in individual searches. These trials are open to all breeds and mixed breeds. Dogs can be blind, lame, 3-legged.

GGPWCF has held three trials, the latest on March 16, 2019. Corgis have been very successful. High in Trial at our second trial was a Corgi owned by Lynn MacLean. Leslie Earl and her "Wonder Corgi" Finn have titled at least 25-30 times! My boy Eddie has earned the Novice Container and Novice Buried titles and is working on his elite titles (10 passing scores).

I think it might be helpful to know what is required. So below are some explanations.

The novice searches are: containers, which consists of 12 closed cardboard boxes with a birch scent item inside; buried which consists of 6 plastic boxes containing dirt with the birch scent item buried 2 inches; interiors which consists of a small interior space with furniture and other items to negotiate around: and exteriors which is really just like interior, but with items typically found outdoors (like hoses and gardening tools). exteriors the birch scent item is hidden on or around the obstacles. For instance, under the lip of a waste basket or in the nozzle of a hose or under a chair seat. Once you have three qualifying scores, a title is earned in that discipline. Then when you have a title in all four search types, you earn the overall novice title - SWN - Scent Work Novice.

There are also advanced, excellent, masters and detective levels. These searches are similar to novice but over a larger area, more “hides”, more boxes/containers and involve more scents. Anise is added at the advanced level and clove is added at the excellent level. Also, in the excellent level and above, you as the handler do not know how many “hides” there are.

If you want to start training your Corgi in scent work, you can find a trainer or you can begin by putting out 6 to 8 small cardboard boxes with interiors that are easily accessible. Use the same box as your “hot box” each time so you do not confuse your Corgi. Place several treats in the boxes and ask your Corgi to search (I say “find it”). When your Corgi finds it, give him/her more treats in the box and praise him/her. That is how you begin. Once you try scent work, you and your Corgi will love it!

Specialty Trivia 1960 to 1989

Golden Gate Pembroke Welsh Corgi Fanciers, Inc. (GGPWCF) became a club in the Fall of 1956. The club held its first Specialty on May 29, 1960 in conjunction with the Del Monte Kennel Club at Pebble Beach, California. The first Specialty had a total of 53 Corgis in competition, about 10% of the 523 total Corgis registered by AKC that year. The Corgi Judge was William Schmick.

Best of Breed was awarded to Am. & Mex. CH Penrick Most Happy Fella, a male bred and owned by GGPWCF members John & Lucy Liecty. Best Opposite Sex was awarded to CH Rover Run Red Rose, bred and owned by GGPWCF founding members Walter & Carol Simonds.

Specialty trivia from 1960 to 1989

- 1961 Specialty Winner CH Willets Red Jacket went on to win Best in Show at the Del Monte Kennel Club.
- 1962 featured GGPWCF's first British judge, Nan Butler of Lees Kennel.
- 1963 was the first independent Specialty.
- 1964 was the first year the Best Puppy award was offered and 1966 was the year the first handpainted Best Puppy Award was offered.
- 1966 Specialty winner was CH Rockrose of Wey thereby retiring the Welsh Corgi League Challenge Trophy which had been won three times by this Specialty Winner.
- 1969 was the first year advertising appeared in the Specialty catalog.
- 1971 was the first time a substitute judge was necessary. Anyone recall why?
- In 1974, the Specialty was held at the Los Gatos Lodge for the first time.
- 1978 was the first time the Specialty included an Obedience Trial with an entry of 33 corgis. CH Gardiner Jones UDT was High In Trial with a score of 191.5.
- 1980 was when the show date was changed from May's Memorial weekend to Mother's Day weekend. This was also the first Specialty where the Tasha Tudor Award for Best of Breed was offered by the national corgi club PWCCA.
- 1981 was the first year Sweepstake classes were offered.
- 1983 saw the retirement of the CH Rockrose of Wey Best of Breed trophy by Robert Simpson for GGPWCF Specialty Best of Breed wins by CH Happiharbor Here's Herbie (1982 & 1983) and CH Schaferhaus Danielle (1975).
- 1984 the CH Schaferhaus Danielle Trophy for Specialty Best of Breed was offered by Robert Simpson. To be retired, the Trophy must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily the same dog.
- 1985 was GGPWCF's first two-day show.
- 1986 Specialty required a second conformation judge, Betty Anne Stenmark, due to a one-day limit of 175 dogs per judge.
- 1988 saw the retirement of the Best Opposite Sex CH Halmor Hi-Fi Memorial Trophy. Janice Edwards had the following Best Opposite Sex Specialty Winners — Ch. Anzil Honey Dew of Blands (1980 and 1981) and CH Jade Tree Just Deserts (1988).
- 1989 was GGPWCF's 30th Specialty with a record entry of 241.

This red and white oozes quality with his correct head proportions and dark eyes, good reach of neck flowing into well laid shoulders enabling him to move with good forward reach. Firm level top line held on the move, good hind angulation. Presented a balanced outline. Pushed his sister hard for Best Puppy.

2. XIV KARAT RIGHT PLACE AT THE RIGHT TIME (XIV Special Place in My Heart at Brigadoon x Graceland XIV Karat Happy Birthday Mr President) Breeder: Sherri Hurst. Owners: Russell Allen, Jason Klawinski & Sherri Hurst. Another quality puppy who is slightly younger than the winner and needs more time for his head to broaden. Liked his overall out line with good lay of shoulders giving him good forward reach, good turn of stifle and short hocks. Covered the ground really well.

3. CEZANNE'S NITE WHISPERS (GCh. Ciregna Thats Amore x Cezanne's Glamette) Owner/Breeder: Judy Charon. Red and white. Very much a baby and needs more time to develop, having said that, he presented a pleasing outline. Showed good forward reach when moving around the ring.

4. FAIR MANOR LIFE OF THE PARTY (GCh. Martindale Black Bart x GCh. Gwyndolyns Rapunzel Rapunzel) Breeder/Owner: Jacqueline Bousquet. Tri colour with kind alert expression and dark eyes. Neat front and feet. A better reach of neck would improve his overall balance. Good length of loin and hind angulation with short hocks, level top line held on the move.

PUPPY DOGS 9 TO 12 MONTHS (1 entered, 0 absent)

1. PINEMEADE DRAGON STONE (GCh. Martindale Black Bart x Ch. Pinemeade Dragon Joy) Breeders/Owners: Terry Hansen & Shannon Stone. Quality tri colour with masculine head and expression, dark eyes and correct ear set. Well let down in front, ample bone carried down to correct shaped feet, (one of the few). Well laid shoulders leading into level top line held on the move, good turn of stifle and short hocks. Very promising puppy.

DOGS 12 TO 18 MONTHS (4 entered, 1 absent)

1. NEBRIOWA JOHNNIE WALKER (GCh. Rosewood Sea Quest x Nebriowa Georgianna) Breeders/Owners: Thomas Mathiesen & Thomas Dedini. Tri colour of excellent type with kind alert expression, pleasing head type, well let down in front, good shoulder angulation giving him good forward reach. Level top line held on the move. Covered the ground with purpose. Standing presented a balanced outline.

2. TRENGATE PICK A CARD (GCh. Trengate Sleight of Hand x Trengate Riding Shotgun) Breeders/Owners: Nissa Lindstrom & Sylvia Nolan. Attractive red and white. Correct front with good bone and feet. Liked his overall, balance good length of loin and turn of stifle. Very attentive showman. I was splitting hairs between the first and second placings.

3. BRNAYR CRESCENDO (Ch. Brynlea Willowisp I Got Rhythm x Ch. Brnayr April In Paris) Breeders/Owners: Ann Marie Buonanno & Vicki Lubarsky. Black headed tri colour, kind alert expression. Well let down in front with good bone. Level top line held on the move, hind angulation could be better.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER DOGS (1 entered, 0 absent)

1. ZEPHYR'S DELICIOUS BLACK FOREST CAKE (Zephyr's The Magician x Zephyr's I Hope You Dance) Breeders: Judith Neuhaus, Thomas & Lois Keffer. Owners: Judith Neuhaus, Geoff & Wendy Hicks. Tri colour, very attractive head with dark eyes. Good front and neat feet. Shoulder angulation could be better but he held his top line moving out well. Good hind angulation and short hocks. Very attentive showman.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOGS (2 entered, 0 absent)

1. TRIAD HIGHLY HUGGABLE (GCh. Martindale Black Bart x GCh. Triad Pandorable) Breeder: Patty Gailey. Owners: Sharyl Waldron & Patty Gailey. Red headed tri colour of quality. Head of correct proportions and a kind expression with lovely dark eyes. Well let down in front, good reach of neck and well laid shoulders leading into level top line that held on the move, good turn of stifle. Covered the ground with drive showing excellent side gait. Liked his overall balance, presented in good coat and condition. **RESERVE WINNERS DOG**

2. NEBRIOWA JAMESON (GCh. Rosewood Sea Quest x Nebriowa Georgianna) Breeders/Owners: Thomas Mathiesen & Thomas Dedini. Red and white with correct head proportions. Neat

front and feet, good bone. Good hind angulation. Not quite the length of body as the winner. Moved out well. Liked both these dogs and could see them changing places.

Red and white. Attractive masculine head and expression. Ample bone carried down to neat front and feet. Good length of loin, and turn of stifle, short hocks giving him driving action from the rear. Presented a balanced outline.

2. EVANWHIT ANGEL ENCORE (GCh. Tromba's Bandalino x Ch. Evanwhit Angel Serenade) Breeder/Owner: Barbara Evans. Red and white. Pleasing head and expression, well let down in front, good turn of stifle. Top line held on the move, outline spoiled by the heaviness in his shoulders. Moved okay.

3. NEBRIOWA MISTER SPATS AT WILDWOOD (GCh Tromba's Bandalino x Nebriowa Tap Shoes) Breeders/Owners: Robin Taylor & Thomas Mathiesen. Red and white with lovely dark eyes. Neat front and feet. I felt he is a little close coupled which spoils his overall balance, and movement.

4. FAIR MANOR DEBONAIR HEIR (GCh. Martindale Black Bart x Fair Manor Laurel) Breeder: Jacqueline Bousquet. Owners: Melaine Koons & Jacqueline Bousquet. Attractive tri colour with a kind expression and correct head shape. Good reach of neck and shoulder placement, level top line and good hind angulation, needed to move with more drive. Presented a pleasing outline.

OPEN DOGS (8 entered, 1 absent)

1. RAINTREES JP DER ROSENKAVALIER. (GCh. Heartsong Brynlea Pavarotti x GCh. Raintrees JP Autumn Splendor) Breeder: Atsumi Kunishio Bizenshi. Owners: Atsumi Kunishio & Naomi Chikayuki. This quality, mature red and white, caught my eye the moment he entered the ring and he did not disappoint when going over him. He has a masculine head with a kind alert expression, eye colour blended with the colour of his coat. Liked his depth of brisket, ample bone carried down to neat feet. Good reach of neck leading into well laid shoulders. Firm level top line with good turn of stifle and short hocks, covered the ground with drive showing excellent side gate. His sound correct movement won him the class. Presented a nicely balanced outline when standing.

WINNERS DOG

2. BRNAYR DAYDREAM BELIEVER (GCh. Woodsedge Brynlea Noir Like Me x Ch. Brnayr Shameless) Breeders/Owners: Ann Marie Buonanno & Vicki Lubarsky. Another quality red and white with a masculine head with a kind expression, not as dark in eye as the winner but it did blend with his coat colour. Correct front and neat feet. Good reach of neck and well laid shoulders. Level top line held on the move, good hind angulation enabling him to move out with drive.

3. CARIADH PAINTING THE TOWN, RN CGC (Ch. Cariadh Man About Town, RN x GCh. Cariadh Cierra Temptation Eyes) Breeder: Patricia Smith. Owners: Amy Jordan, Robert Jordan & Patricia Smith. Red and white with kind expression. Good depth of brisket with good bone and neat feet. Hind movement better than front which was a touch wide. Standing he presented a balanced outline

Foxtails and Your Dogs

Foxtails seem to be in abundance in California this year, putting our dogs at risk. Foxtails can dig through skin or be inhaled; embedded foxtails can cause discharge, abscesses, swelling, pain, and death. After being near foxtails, if your dog is displaying any of the following symptoms, check for foxtails or talk to your vet.

Feet. Foxtails love your dog's feet and can easily become embedded between toes. Check for foxtails if you notice swelling or limping or if your dog is constantly licking the area.

Ears. If your dog is shaking his head, tilting it to the side, or scratching incessantly at an ear, this could be the sign of a foxtail — one that may be so deep inside the ear canal you can't see it. Your veterinarian needs to take a look using a special scope. *Editor note: Recently, my corgi Layla had a foxtail removed from deep in her ear canal by our vet. Luckily it had not yet pierced her ear drum.*

Eyes. Redness, discharge, swelling, squinting, and pawing all may be signs your dog has a foxtail lodged in its eye. If you think this may be the case, seek veterinary care immediately.

Nose. If you see discharge from the nose, or if your dog is sneezing frequently and intensely, there may be a foxtail lodged in a nasal passage.

Genitals. Foxtails can find their way into these areas, too. So if you notice your dog persistently liking at its genitals, foxtails could be the cause.

Prevention Tips:

- ☑ The easiest way to prevent foxtail problems is to keep your dog out of overgrown, grassy areas and make sure foxtail plants are removed from your yard.
- ☑ Be diligent and closely examine your dog(s) during foxtail season, generally May through December, especially if you've gone walking in open fields.
- ☑ Use tweezers to remove any foxtails you can easily get to. Visit your vet if the foxtail is embedded, or if the area is red or swollen.
- ☑ Remember, foxtails won't come out on their own and they can burrow anywhere.
