If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

Rules for entering this trial:

DO NOT COME IF YOU FEEL SICK!!! (If the club is able to fill your entries from the wait list, your entry fees will be refunded.)

1. DO NOT COME if you have traveled out of the state and have not sheltered in place for 14 days!

2. DO NOT COME if you have been to any large gatherings within the 14 days prior to this trial!

Grounds rules:

1. NO overnight & NO day of RV parking.
2. NO smoking allowed on the grounds.
3. You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle idling in the parking area.
4. There will be a door monitor, you may not enter the building on your own.
5. Once you exit the ring you will need to exit the building.
6. You will not be allowed to watch from inside the building.
7. Check - in will be done outside the building.
8. Crating – there will be NO crating in the building. You will be required to crate from your vehicle. Bring canopies and/or shade cloth. Please keep dogs quiet, if barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave. Keep dogs on leash while not working, potty areas are described in the Judging Program.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Covid 19 – best practices:

1. Participants are required to follow state, local, and facility guidelines that are in effect at the time of the event.
2. You will be required to wear a mask (face covering) while in the building. You may not enter the building if you are not wearing a mask, which means you will be required to wear a mask in the ring while competing with your dog. You must bring your own mask!
3. For parking – there are 17 spaces next to the building, 20 spaces across the street and street parking is free.
4. Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
5. Wear masks when in close proximity to others.
6. If you utilize the portable toilet, sanitize your hands before and after you enter.
7. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
8. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

- 1 HOW TO ENTER:
 - **MAIL** - To be acceptable, submit entry, with the required entry fee, on an official AKC entry form, or copy, including the agreement and instructions. Please type or neatly print. **NO HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- 2 The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.
- 3 Entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries specifying any condition as to acceptance cannot be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, telephone, fax or email entries will not be accepted.
- 4 The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- 5 **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT:**
 - MAILED entries will receive an email confirmation within 7 days after receipt, if an email address is provided on the entry form, otherwise, the confirmation will be sent via USPS standard mail.
- 6 If acknowledgments are not received by an exhibitor 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- 7 Consult Judging Schedule for time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged. We suggest dogs be present one hour before scheduled time of judging.
- 8 Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.
- 9 The Club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss or injury.
- 10 Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.
- 11 There shall be no drilling, intensive or corrective training of dogs on Trial grounds or premises.
- 12 In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize.
- 13 Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, or if it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the Trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 14 MOVE-UPS (Class Transfers) will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary in writing as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes prior to start of Trial judging.
- 15 BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the Club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
