ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

-Please note - this trial site is private property. Please keep your dogs and/ or children away from the residence and its fenced yard. Do not 'potty' your dogs near the fence around the house.

-Please be courteous and pick up after you dog.

-All dogs MUST be on leash at all times, except when competing.

-It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund on any fees paid will be made.

-Please do not throw garbage in Port-a-Potties.

-Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian, Judge, or Tester or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or entry fee will be made.

-Dogs must be ready for their classes. Test/Trial judges have the authority to refuse to judge any dog, which does not appear within five minutes of being called for its run.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST/TRIAL SITE

From the North - Go I-5 south to the Patterson/Sperry Ave. Exit, Go left on Sperry and go 2.7 miles to stop sign. Turn Right on Hwy 33, go 0.7 mile. Take a Left on Almond and go 1 mile. At the stop sign, Go Right on Sycamore. Go 1.2 miles and watch for herding trial signs on the left.

From the South - Go I-5 North to the Patterson/Sperry Ave. Exit, Go right on Sperry and go 2.7 miles to stop sign. Turn Right on Hwy 33, go .7 mile. Take a Left on Almond and go 1 mile. At the stop sign, Go Right on Sycamore. Go 1.2 miles and watch for herding trial signs on the left.

From the West - Take 580 heading towards Tracy. After you come down the Altamont on 580, just past Grant Line Rd., stay in either of the right two lanes and veer right staying on South 580. After your veer right, go approx. 19 miles and take the Patterson/Sperry Ave. Exit, Go left on Sperry and go 2.7 miles to stop sign. Turn Right on Hwy 33, go 0.7 mile. Take a Left on Almond and go 1 mile. At the stop sign, Go Right on Sycamore. Go 1.2 miles and watch for herding trial signs on the left.

From 99 - North or South - Take the West Main exit in Turlock and go West on West Main. Go 13.6 miles to Sycamore. (West Main turns into Las Palmas after you cross the river as you are getting near Patterson) Turn left (south) on Sycamore. Go 2.7 miles and watch for herding trial signs on the left.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. I (we) will pay for any injuries or the replacement value in this event of serious injury to the livestock caused by my (our) dog. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of any injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage.
